## Kick Off for “*Dine In Queens 2016*”

*(The Shops at Atlas Park, Glendale, NY) — With 14 eateries offering free samples, the Queens Tourism Council will kick off its annual eating extravaganza, **Dine In Queens 2016**, at The Shops at Atlas Park in Glendale on Tuesday, October 11, at noon. (Please note that this promotion used to be called “Queens Restaurant Week.”)*

In addition to a free lunch, kick off attendees will be able to take photos and interview bistro owners, event sponsors, event organizers, and elected officials.

Roughly 100 restaurants — spread throughout the borough — will participate in this 13th annual food fest.
